

**Mountain View College**  
**Spring 2007 Credit Student Enrollment Change Analysis**  
**May 7, 2007**  
**Executive Summary**

The Spring 2007 census headcount of 6,703 students at Mountain View College is 6.3% more than the 6,305 students enrolled in Spring 2006. Spring 2007 also reached record high number of credit students for MVC spring semesters.

The following bullets summarize where the greatest changes occurred comparing Spring 2007 to Spring 2006.

**Unduplicated Student Headcount Highlights**

**Demographics:**

- Hispanic students increased 9 % (242) with Hispanic males increasing the most 11%
- Students age 15 and below increased by 98 because of the Early College High School
- Students in age groups 26-30 years and 36-40 years increased 11% and 12% respectively

**Classification:**

- Part-time students increased 9% (399)
- Second year (sophomore) part-time students increased 11% (166)
- Part-time students who already hold a degree increased 21% (192)

**Residence:**

- Out of district (in Texas) increased 34% (114) (Mostly Tarrant and Ellis county residents)
- Out of country residents increased by 12 (15%)

**Other Headcount Highlights:**

- Dual Credit students increased 22% (75)
- ECHS Dual Credit added another 102 students

**Duplicated Student Course Enrollments Highlights**

- Overall student course enrollments increased 7.1% (1,110 higher than Spring 2006)
- Distance learning online enrollments increased 909 (84%)
- Self-paced enrollments decreased 399 students (-32%)

**Instructional Division Highlights:**

- Communications and Teacher Education Division enrollments increased 353 (9%)
- Science, Allied Health, and Physical Education Division enrollments increased 190 (11%)
- Student Support Services HDEV course enrollments increased 114 (60%)
